PRE-COURSE REQUIREMENTS

1. You must have in your possession a Healthcare Provider CPR Bring your current Health Care Provider CPR card with you TO the 1st day of class session (a must!!!)
2. All applicants must be at least 18 years of age or older.
3. The course fee is \$ 275.00. Make checks or money orders payable to CSC. No refunds for unsuccessful completion of course or no show. There will be no refunds for dropping out without one-week notice prior to course start date. Fees collected represent no income to the American Heart Association.
4. Please bring a 2 inch binder with you to class. You will put all of your class information in this binder. **DO NOT FORGET!**
5. You will be provided with an AHA BLS INSTRUCTOR ESSENTIALS book once we receive this registration with payment for this course. You may pick it up, or we will mail it to you. You need to complete the instructor essentials course on line using the included registration number, before the start of the class. At the end of the core class the program will ask you to print a certificate. This certificate **MUST** be printed out & turned in at the First Class Session. **NO EXCEPTIONS!**
6. Other AHA Course materials will be handed out at class.
7. **THE FIRST NITE THERE WILL BE A WRITTEN AND SKILLS EVALUATION. BE PREPARED TO BE EVALUATED ON ALL YOUR CPR SKILLS. THESE INCLUDE: ADULT, CHILD, AND INFANT CPR AND FBAO. ALL STUDENTS MUST PASS THIS EVALUATION IN ORDER TO MOVE ON.** Please take the time to practice, preferably with an AHA CPR instructor. Until you are proficient in your skills.
8. Plan on teaching CPR courses (not just to have instructor credentials). A minimum of 2 courses processed thru CSC a year must be taught to keep your instructor credentials current.
